CIRCULAR

Consequent upon urgent requisition of some information about the centers of legal education affiliated to our University by the Bar Council of India, following an order passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Madras in W.P. Nos. 25215, 26085, 26177 and 26556 of 2017 to furnish some details in relation to the students and the teaching staff of the centers of legal education, you are requested to **immediately** (within **four working days** from the date of issue of this circular) **submit** the following information to the Registrar of the University, with a copy to the undersigned, for onward transmission to the BCI:

- 1) Total number of students admitted and total numbers of students who have come out successfully from your college during last 10 years (**Year wise data**);
- 2) Details of all teaching staff working in your college (furnish in the attached format), and
- 3) Action taken by your college to implement recommendations made by the Legal Education Committee on 23.09.2017 regarding online attendance system ("*Therefore, the Committee further stated that it is desirable and recommended that all centers of legal education should make sincere, all possible efforts to start online attendance system within one year.*").

-----Recommendation by the Legal Education Committee on 23.09.2017 that online attendance system started by/at certain centers of legal education is an example which will curtail the absence of students while teaching is going on, therefore, it is desirable and recommended by the committee that all Centers of Legal education should make sincere, all possible efforts to start online attendance system within one year AND Query raised by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W. P. Nos.25215, 26085, 26177 & 26556 of 2017 in its order dated 25.10.2017 as to why not the Bar Council of India make the biometric attendance system mandatory for the students as well as the staffs of the law colleges, as many of the law colleges are selling degrees in absentia, without even conducting classes and without having any infrastructures?

In light of the order dated 25.10.2017 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W. P. Nos.25215, 26085, 26177 & 26556 of 2017, you are again requested to urgently submit the total numbers of the students admitted and total numbers of students who have come out successfully from the law colleges affiliated to your university and from the Department of Law of your University during last 10 years (Year wise and college wise), through return mail.

Furthermore, you are also urgently requested to forthwith furnish details of all teaching staff working in law colleges/institutions/Centers of legal education/University Department's by return mail.

It is brought to your urgent and kind attention that the Legal Education Committee on 23.09.2017 was of the view that online attendance system started by/at certain centers of legal education is an example which will curtail the absence of students while teaching is going on. Therefore, the Committee further stated that it is desirable and recommended that all Centers of Legal education should make sincere, all possible efforts to start online attendance system within one year. This recommendation/direction of the Legal Education Committee found its reflection in the query raised by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W. P. Nos.25215, 26085, 26177 & 26556 of 2017 in its order dated 25.10.2017 as to why not the Bar Council of India make the biometric attendance system mandatory for the students as well as the staffs of the law colleges, as many of the law colleges are selling degrees in absentia, without even conducting classes and without having any infrastructures?

Therefore, in lieu of it you are requested to kindly adhere to the recommendation of the Legal Education Committee referred to above and take a serious note of the query raised by the Hon'ble Court as mentioned above and do the needful.

The Hon'ble High Court is awaiting this information. Therefore, you are requested to treat this mail as TOP MOST PRIORITY AND VERY URGENT and provide the information IMMEDIATELY latest within one week through return mail.
