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CIRCULAR

Consequent upon introduction of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in the postgraduate courses of studies offered by the University of Kalyani it has since been implemented with effect from the current academic session (2017-18). The PG departments of studies of the university have offered 'open choice courses' (course 2.1) of their preference to the students of 2nd semester. However, seven affiliated colleges offering lone or very few PG courses are facing trouble to cope up with the situation.

The matter was under active consideration of the university authority and after giving a careful and sympathetic thought it has been decided that the affiliated colleges offering PG courses, keeping parity with the curriculum followed by the respective PG department of teaching of the university, may offer 'open choice courses' (course 2.1) to their 2nd semester PG students through an in-house mechanism but only after due approval from the university.

For that purpose the college authority should identify maximum three departments of teaching (from each of science and/or humanities/social science/language disciplines as applicable) in their own institution, which according to them have sufficient faculty strength and are competent enough to offer the 'open choice courses' (course 2.1) in their own disciplines as has been prepared by the university for the purpose. The college authority should submit (with due approval from their respective Governing Bodies) the names of such identified departments of teaching in their respective institutions, along with necessary teachers' details in the given format (**vide enclosure**), before the university authority seeking permission. Such applications should preferably be submitted within five working days from the date of issue of this circular.

This circular is issued in concurrence with the Vice-Chancellor, vide docket no. VC/66378.
