**Selection procedure:**

1. For eligibility, exemption etc. candidates may go through 'Ph.D. Regulation 2016 / M.Phil. Regulation 2016' available in the University website: [www.klyuniv.ac.in](http://www.klyuniv.ac.in).
2. Reservation and relaxation **as per Govt. / U.G.C. rules.**
3. Separate forms to be filled up for M.Phil. and Ph.D., however there will be Common Entrance Test for M. Phil & Ph.D.
4. Entrance test will be conducted in the model of NET-UGC/CSIR, SET and such other examination
5. The Ph.D. and M.Phil. Common entrance test (EEARP) will be held with OMR sheets based on 50 MCQ type question carrying 2 marks each.
6. Student willing to apply for Ph.D. in more than one subject must fill in separate forms for each subject. But they must mention the subject in which they wish to appear in written examination (EEARP).
7. Candidates, who qualified in Admission Test for Ph.D. in Kalyani University (K.U.) earlier, are also exempted from written examination (EEARP).
8. Selected candidates have to produce no objection Certificate from their Employer during the time of Admission
9. Qualifying marks in written examination (EEARP) is 50%.
10. Final Selection will be based on
  - a) Academic achievement 80%
  - b) Interview 20%
